NYPD: Arizona Mom Arrested For Kidnapping Child

NEW YORK (AP) — Police say they have arrested an Arizona mother for kidnapping her child and bringing her to the Bronx. On Tuesday night, the baby was reunited with her father.



Bill Savicki was finally reunited with his 17-month-old daughter in New York.

Bill Savicki arrived in Manhattan for the reunion with his daughter, 17-month-old Caiden Savicki, who was missing since late June when her troubled mother fled Arizona with her after losing custody. For the frantic father, it's been a very long summer.

"Sitting at home, not seeing my daughter, just going to work every day and trying to keep my head together, there were some tough times. Obviously I thought everything I could possibly

think," he said.

The mother, Kristin Murray, planned on using our town for her and her daughter to get lost in. But it turns out the Big Apple wasn't big enough. Volunteers from a Pennsylvania-based charity group called the "Association for Lost Children" took the case and using a single credit card clue, tracked her.

The group began canvassing methadone clinics, narrowing the list as they went. Investigator Candace Harrison found the mother and child.

"We hung outside and asked questions and I pretended to be her sister... once they thought I was a relative they were willing to help me," she said.

"We do everything ourselves. We find the children, do the surveillance, undercover work, take people's trash, play different roles, pizza delivery man, whatever it takes. And once we either lay our eyes on the child, or in this case know where they're at, then we go get the police, and not beforehand," explained Buddy Hall, another investigator.

Little Caiden was in custody with the ACS Tuesday night.
